Sports Knowledge

There is a misconception that having knowledge of a specific sport or a team will make you a successful sports bettor. People who know a lot about sports can use their knowledge to their advantage. The challenge is, oddsmakers know a lot too. They have access to statistics others don't and sophisticated systems for generating odds.

While betting on your favorite team can make a game more exciting to watch, remember that it's less about betting for or against one team and more about betting for or against the posted odds. Understanding the sport is great, but you need to be informed about what you are really betting on.



Common Ways to Bet

In Manitoba, sports betting is offered at retail through Lotto Spots and online at PlayNow. com. Just like other forms of gambling, it's a good idea to understand sports betting before you place a bet. Here are a few key concepts to know:

- Parlay A bet on a minimum of two outcomes up to as many as allowed by that game. All your predictions must be correct to win.
- **Single Event** A bet on a single outcome and only one correct prediction is required to win. This can include "Live In-Play Betting" as well.
- Money line A bet on which team will win.
 It doesn't matter what the final score is, only who wins.
- Spread betting A bet on which team will beat the spread, an assigned number which handicaps one team and favors another. The favorite "takes" points from the final score and the underdog "gives" points.
- Over/Under bets A bet made based on the combined final score between both teams.
- Outright betting A bet on the outcome of a series of matches such as an entire season or tournament.
- **Proposition bets** A bet made on a very specific outcome of a match, not related to the final score.

Online Tools

If you play online, PlayNow.com has information and tools that can help you manage your play so you can keep enjoying the game.

Account History - If you're wanting to keep track of your play, you have access to your Account History where you can view all transactions for the past 6 months. The transactions can be filtered so they can show certain gameplay, payments or both.

Also, under My Account at the bottom of the home page look for:

Weekly deposit limit - Within any seven-day period, you will only be able to deposit up to the total amount which you selected. You can decrease your Weekly Deposit Limit at any time. Decreasing your limit happens immediately.

Voluntary short-term account lockout -

Allows you to temporarily restrict your access to PlayNow.com for anywhere from 24 hours to 14 days - you will be unable to access all games as well as all account management features. When that time is up you can return.

Voluntary Self-Exclusion (VSE) -

If you are looking for a more permanent timeout, visit the Support & Exclusion tab on informedgambling.ca. VSE is a way to help people honour their decision to take a break from gambling.
